

Florence Street Main Replacement Project: Two Planned Water Service Shutoffs Next Week

Dear Valued Customer.

During the week of August 12, 2024, water service to your home will be temporarily shut off <u>twice</u> while Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD) connects your water service line to the new water main serving SW Florence Street, then disconnects the old water main from the water system.

Shut Off Details

First Shutoff

- Date: Will occur on one of the following days:
 - Monday, August 12 OR
 - Tuesday, August 13
- Time: Between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Duration: 30 minutes per house
- Notice: The crew will knock on your door before temporarily shutting off your water service.

NOTE: During the first shut off, TVWD will be connecting each home's water service line to the new water main. Because this work happens one home at a time, we can't give you a specific time for when water service to your home will be shut off.

Second Shutoff

Date: Wednesday, August 14Time: From 9 a.m. to 12 noon

• Duration: 3 hours

During Shutoff Work

• Heavy equipment and trucks will be temporarily located at the work site.

- You will experience noise, vibration, and dust.
- · Access to your home will be maintained.

Next Step: Permanent Paving

After connecting your water service line to the new water main and disconnecting the old water main from the system, temporary patches will be placed on SW Florence Street. This will help to maintain traffic flow while preparations for permanent paving are underway.

Later this year, a contractor will remove these temporary patches and proceed with permanent paving of Florence Street. Watch for an email confirming the paving date(s).
