Pre-Construction Surveying Planned for Summer Ahead of 2025 Water Main Replacement Project

Dear Valued Customer,

This summer (June/July 2024), a land surveyor will be in your neighborhood gathering data that will inform the design and construction of an upcoming water main replacement project, which is detailed below.

The surveyor will not require access to private property during this process. The surveying activities will involve data collection, utility identification, and marking of pavement within public rights-of-way and easements.

Water Main Replacement Project

To strengthen the water system serving your neighborhood, Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD) – your drinking water provider – will be replacing about 800 feet of the current water main along NW 123rd Place, south of NW Hartford Street, with new 4-inch and 8-inch ductile iron water main.

Water mains are underground pipes that carry treated drinking water from a water treatment plant to a customer's home or business.

Project Timeline

Construction on the [123rd Water Main Replacement Project](#) is expected to begin in early 2025 and last a little over a month.

- Design: In progress
- Construction begins: Early 2025
- Construction ends: A little over a month after the project begins

*Dates are subject to change. TVWD will provide timely updates should any delays arise to ensure minimal inconvenience to our valued customers.

Project Updates

TVWD will provide detailed information to customers in the public outreach area closer to when the project begins. Information will include the construction schedule, impacts, and what customers can expect during the process.

TVWD maintains over 760 miles of underground water mains.

Aging water mains can be prone to leaks and breaks. TVWD's Water Main Replacement Program systematically identifies the most susceptible water mains in the water distribution system. They are then replaced with newer, more durable pipes to enhance their reliability and reduce the frequency of water service interruptions to customers.

Each year, TVWD replaces thousands of feet of water main in neighborhoods across our [service area](#). Main replacement projects are funded by water rates.
