

Goyak Reservoir and Pump Station Site: Portion of Fencing Complete

Greetings, Valued Customer,

Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD) has finished installing a portion of fencing along the eastern and southern real property line surrounding the Goyak Reservoir and Pump Station site at SW 189th Avenue and SW Rigert Road. Also, asphalt and vegetation were removed from the southeast area of the reservoir to allow fence installation.

The final portion of fencing will be installed on the north side of the reservoir site after demolition of the reservoir and pump station in 2025.

Fencing will help the site to remain secure and operational.

The fencing and future removal of the Goyak Reservoir and Pump Station is part of the 189th Pump Station and Pipeline Project, currently underway in this area of the community. This project includes:

- Removing the existing pump stations and reservoirs at TVWD's 189th property (189th Avenue/SW Hart Road) and Goyak property (189th Avenue/Rigert Road).
- Building a new pump station at the 189th property.
- Installing new water transmission pipeline from the 189th property to the Goyak property.


